**1b. Request Human Resources**

Providers work with Labor Unions and Service Training Guides to select compensation factor levels, certification, and training requirements.

Citizens request services from Independent Service Providers through either the Standard Needs Earned Equity or WAWT markets

2. Human Resources Administration (HRA):

1) Receives Job/Task Orders; confirms work hardship, education, and hierarchy levels for compensation

2) Certification checked and skills matched (iLearn)

**Term Definition: BEE**

The Base Energy Expense rate is calculated based on the standards of the Willit Compensation Calculator (WCC).

The WCC is a global labor energy expense rate calculation used to determine the true cost of all labor for production and for the provision of services.

The rate of compensation is based on: Job Hardship, Education Level, the Position's Hierarchy, and Lifespan Expectancy factors.

The People / Person

People agree to work (there is no forced labor). One can select to participate as a Standard Needs Earned Equity Member Only, or work in the Capital Markets and earn Willits.

Earned Equity (EE)

Earned Equity is calculated by taking the total man hours required for the production of all Standard Needs and dividing all man hour requirements by the number of able-bodied persons.

The Earned Equity Energy Expense (E4) requirement is the hours one must contribute to be in good standing. Those who work in the Standard Needs System, are entitled to access the agreed upon Standard Need items and services without additional cost: Food, Housing, medical services, utilities, communication system etc.

Earned Equity workers also earn Willits for efficient production so they can purchase the goods and services they desire from the Capital Markets (WAWT)

Willits for Earned Equity/Standard Needs Worker

Willits are earned if one is requested to work overtime, and bonuses (Willit Compensation) are paid quarterly to all Standard Needs Earned Equity Members for efficient production.

All Citizens whether EE or Capital Markets, receive bonuses for maintaining their health and healthy relationships with other members of society. Bonuses are not included in the True Cost calculation for product pricing.

Willits are a living breathing currency and transferable only for the trade of goods and services. Unused Willit expires upon an individual's death.

Member Login:

Member logs into the Willit compensation/equity module when they arrive at their employer's work site, to confirm their arrival time (computer based, card swipe, and GPS). Offline workers login to the Mobile Labor Force Tracking System.

9. iAct (module integration) Tracks production yield and service provision

Work Begins

Workers note everything they are instructed to do, confirm their yields, and report violations of their production or service agreement and hazards.

Workers report all violations with use of (iEffect) so the Workforce Oversight Administration (WOA) may place a Stop Action Order, if required.

The Willit System ensure the individuals that make up the Labor Force are treated as valuable members of society and ensure the protection of Human and Labor Rights.

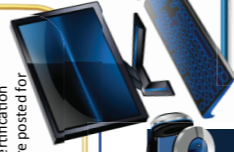
